As we know you are aware of, we continue to be a volunteer run organization with a budget of less than five thousand dollars a year.

THE MAIN STREET WINDOW PROJECT

Naomi Bushof Fair Oaks and Matt Sherman of Liberty presented "The Window Project", an installation featuring Naomi's award-winning historical dolls complemented with brightly colored backdrops, which lighted up Liberty's Main Street throughout our very difficult winter.

Naomi and Matt felt the need to bring a joyful presence to Main Street during the months that the Museum could not open.

Naomi also ran two weekend doll-making and butterfly-creation workshops for children in the community, all presented at no cost to the participants. Many of the children's creations were added to the window displays. Just walking by the windows brought many a smile to passersby.

Matt will be offering mixed-media and collage workshops for children during the summer season. These will be offered one Sunday per month, the dates to be announced. In addition, Naomi will be continuing her workshops and community outreach. The Museum has been an integral part of the revitalization of Main Street for the past 25 years and these projects continue our commitment to the community.

The Liberty Museum, celebrating its 25th anniversary this year, is committed to providing the art and history exhibitions as well as interactive programs that are essential parts of our mission, regardless of the external circumstances.
